To indicate short quotations (four typed lines or fewer of prose or three lines of verse) in your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

Place a parenthetical citation either immediately after the quotation or at the end of the sentence. For a narrative citation, include the author and year in the sentence and then place the page number or other location... If the quotation precedes the narrative citation, put the page number or ...

Use in-text citations for quotes. Place parentheses with the proper citation inside after directly after quoted material. APA style uses the author-date message.This means that if you write the name of an author you are quoting, you must follow that name with the year of publication in parentheses.

Place the in-text citation after the quotation marks. For quotations at the end of the sentence, write the in-text citation after the quotation marks and before the period. Page number is preceded by p. for only one page and pp. for two or more pages. Include the abbreviated word para. before the paragraph number for works without pagination.

### APA Quote Citation | APA Format

The Chicago style of formatting research essays uses footnotes at the bottom of your page rather than in-text parenthetical citations. In order to cite a quotation in your paper, add a footnote number immediately after the ending quotation mark (not inside the quotes). This should be paired with a matching citation at the bottom of the page.

Place the last name of the quoted author in parenthesis following the end of the quotation if you do not provide a name in the text as a citation. For example, instead of writing John Doe's name, you might write the following: The data was found to be accurate.

Put quotation marks around the direct quote. Use quotation marks anytime you include someone else's words in your own paper. This lets the reader know that you have borrowed from another writer. As long as you use quotation marks and cite the source where you got the material, you can use someone else's ideas without plagiarizing.

If you want to use material that you found quoted in another source (without including any of that source's own text), you can quote it as normal and add an indirect citation. The convention for indirect citing depends on the citation style. In MLA in-text citations, you use “qtd. in,” short for “quoted in,” to cite indirectly.

### How to Quote Sources | Introduce, Shorten and Cite Quotes

Introduce the quotation in prose ending with a colon. Follow the introduction by positioning the quotation in a separate block of text. There is no need to use quotation marks. Instead, format the block so it is indented 1 inch from the left as compared to the rest of the text.

Place your parenthetical citation immediately after the quote. Even if the quoted passage occurs in the middle of a sentence, the citation follows immediately. An MLA in-text citation typically includes the name of the author and the page number. If the name of the author appears in your text, all you need is the page number.

Give the secondary source in the reference list; in text, name the original work and give a citation for the secondary source. For example, if Allport's work is cited in Nicholson and you did not read Allport's work, list the Nicholson reference in the reference list. In the text, use the following citation:

You should quote a famous saying as it appears in a primary or secondary source and then cite that source. While it is acceptable to cite a famous saying from a Web site or a book that lists famous quotations, quoting from the original source provides readers with more context and could strengthen the argument you are making.

To create an in-text citation for this, include the name of the speaker in the parenthetical citation brackets followed by a comma and the year of the airing. When you want to include the name (s) of the speaker (s) into the text itself, paraphrase their quote and state the author with the year in brackets. [Quote] (Krasdale, 2010)
